1. Scholarship Application Form and Scholarship Bank Transfer Request Form (Attachments)

Please fill in the required information (outlined in bold) on each form and submit them to the place of application specified on the first page.

* Students are only eligible to apply for this scholarship if they have completed the 2014 Fall Semester Scholarship Applicant Registration. Please make sure to complete the Scholarship Applicant Registration during the allotted time period.

2. Photocopy of Cash Card or Bank Book (the page showing the account number and the account holder's name in kana. The account must be in the name of the student.)

* The following are not accepted at Keio for scholarship bank transfers: JP Bank, JA Bank, trust banks, credit associations, foreign banks, convenience store banks, Aozora Bank, Shinsei Bank, and web bank accounts.

Please note:

If you lose your status as a scholarship student due to a leave of absence, withdrawal from the university, or other such reason, you will be required to refund some or all of the scholarship amount already transferred to you.

If a scholarship student who entered Keio in April takes a temporary leave of absence during Spring Semester 2014, the scholarship amount shall be reduced to half of the yearly amount (one semester).

1 . Keio University Scholarship

- **Objective:** The Keio University Scholarship is designed to support undergraduate students who have high motivation for academic achievement, an excellent academic record, good character, and a high likelihood of successfully completing their studies, but who have financial difficulty in paying study-related expenses. It is to be used for school expenses/academic fees.

- **Eligibility Requirements:**
 - Must not be a non-degree student [with credit], non-degree student [without credit], or short-term international student.
 - Must be a undergraduate student in second year or above.
 - Status of residence must be “Student.”
 - Must not be repeating a year due to poor academic performance the previous year.
 - Must not have any outstanding tuition and other fees up to the Spring Semester 2014.
 - Must have completed the Scholarship Applicant Registration for the Fall Semester 2014.

- **Scholarship Amount:** ¥150,000 per year. Some recipients who are recognized as being high academic achievers will each receive an additional ¥300,000.

- **Scholarship Period:** For students who entered Keio in April, the period is one year from April. For students who entered Keio in September, the period is one year from October. (Students can apply each year.)

2 . Keio Graduate School Scholarship

- **Objective:** The Keio Graduate School Scholarship is designed to support graduate students who have high motivation for academic achievement, an excellent academic record and good character, but who have financial difficulty in paying study-related expenses. It is to be used for school expenses/academic fees.

- **Eligibility Requirements:** This is not for Law School.
 - Must not be a research student, non-degree student [with credit], or short-term international student.
 - Students must not have already received this scholarship for the standard term of their course (two years for a master’s program, three years for a doctoral program, or four years for a doctoral program at the Graduate School of Medicine/Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Major in Pharmacy).
 - Must not have any outstanding tuition and other fees up to the Spring Semester 2014.
 - Must have completed the Scholarship Applicant Registration for the Fall Semester 2014.

- **Scholarship Amount:** ¥150,000 per year. Some recipients who are recognized as being high academic achievers will each receive an additional amount of ¥300,000 for a master’s or doctoral program at the Graduate School of Medicine, Master’s Program at the Graduate Schools of Business Administration, Media and Governance, Health Management, System Design and Management, or Media Design. Students of all other programs and graduate schools may receive an additional amount of ¥100,000.

- **Scholarship Period:** For students who entered Keio in April, the period is one year from April. For students who entered Keio in September, the period is one year from October. (Students can apply each year.)
